FRENCH STAGE OF RAIDS ADVENTURE FROM THE 27TH TO THE 29TH OF AUGUST 2010

Press release - Participation Record!

3rd edition of the Raid in France from 27th to 29th August in the Buech region: with 37 teams engaged on the ARWS circuit of the raid adventure world cup. One month before the final in Spain the racers have chosen France as a warm up.

Thirty-seven teams inscribed on the ARWS circuit, the world cup speciality. A record! Thus the most well known french teams and a selection of high standard europeans. This 3rd edition which will cross the Buech region and the Dévoluy in the Hautes-Alpes during three days non-stop, announces itself as a unique sportive and humane epic. A grandiose repetition within nature before the final in Spain at the end of September.

Raid in France 2010 assures for the 200 participants the crossing of the wildest landscapes of the Hautes-Alpes, in accordance with an itinerary concocted from 'homa made' criterian. Non stop coherent progression, crossing territories where almost no one goes, growing difficulties, total engagement and the possibility to go beyond ones abilities.

You can do it!

The ICDI route "I would like to take participants a step further towards the participation in a grand raid, that is to say a non stop one, in autonomy and within a team, with the criteria of adventure and discovery. The I Can Do It event is a first step. It will take place at the same time as the longer raid, on a shorter portion of the ARWS circuit, with the same rules but in a team of two. This will take about 10 hours for the leaders and a little more for those finishing at the end of the day." Pascal Bahuaud, creator and organiser of the Raid in France is about to win his bet. This year is the set up year, alongside the world cup event, of an initial discovery event in sports adventure: 10 teams are engaged at present.
