# Dear racers,

## Mandatory equipment list philosophy

The mandatory equipment list is a basis to prepare your adventure the best you can, and from which you will have the minimum required to face the elements... The fact that we accept one equipment doesn't mean that it is the more adapted to one activity, or to some kind of weathers you will face, but only that it fits with the definition written in the list.

It is your call to decide what to bring and use in regard to the list, and to complete the equipment list.

#### **Reminders**

During equipment verifications we can mark several clothes (eg. 2 jackets, 2 fleeces...). You need to provide for tying your B bags (waterproof bags) to the kayaks. Monday end of the day in Hauteville-Lompnes, you will have some kayaks at your disposal to prepare yourselves. Be careful with the lights and batteries. A team with not enough light on a boat or no more light on a mountain bike will be forced to stop and to wait until dawn.

Be careful, despite the fact that this year we are not in high altitude, it has frozen this week during nights.

During verifications, teams must:

1/ show the original certificates

2/ fprovide copies of the original certificates, which will be destroyed after the competition
