The 2024 course

Currently, it keeps raining in Corrèze and the surrounding departments. With the rivers carrying a lot of water, final reconnaissance missions will be conducted almost in race configuration at the last moment to ensure the water levels of the proposed courses.

Although no dark zones are currently planned, but depending on the atmospheric conditions during the race, some may be implemented as current weather forecasts predict rather wet and cold conditions.

The terrain you will encounter on your mountain bike (to answer Stéphanie Block :-)) will be of all possible types... even more so depending on the expected weather conditions.

Welcoming and verification

The reception and verification times for teams are: Thursday, June 27th from 2 PM to 7 PM, and Friday, June 28th from 8 AM to 4:30 PM.

Team captains must inform us by email at <u>concurrent@raidinfrance.fr</u> of the approximate day and time of their arrival for administrative and equipment checks. The entire team does not need to be present for this, but the attending members must bring all the required documents for the team as well as all the equipment of the four racers for a joint verification.

For teams that have not yet done so, please provide us as soon as possible with the FFTri competition licenses or equivalent for foreign teams, if you have them. The competition license serves as a medical certificate.

A deposit of €300 will be requested at reception for the equipment made available to you. This can be paid by credit card (except American Express) or check.



Closing ceremony

About forty places are available for team guests (limited number of spots) at a price of \leq 20 for adults and \leq 15 for children.

Race logistics

Mountain bike - Bike boxes, even if covered with plastic, are not accepted. We offer compliant boxes for sale that meet ARWS regulations and airline standards at a price of €165.

These boxes will be delivered at the start during the checks or can be picked up in Lyon upon request. They are made of 5mm PPEA with a top opening and secured by 3 buckle straps.

The weight of the different boxes and the bag can be found in the equipment rotation sheet.

Inspections will be carried out during the race.

Mandatory equipment

White water- We allow drysuits as well as full neoprene sets (pants + long-sleeved jacket).

Don't forget that it might be cold, especially at night. All navigation will be done in packrafts; there is no kayak section.

Garmin watches - Garmin watches are accepted as altimeters only if they have the Adventure Race mode. In this case, teams must notify us at reception, and the verification procedure will be explained to them. Make sure to bring the charging cable to be able to restart the watch in case of a complete discharge upon arrival, in order to check the watch's status

If the watch is changed or restarted in normal mode during the race, thepenalty will be either a time penalty or disqualification.
